Visit of US Ambassador at Moanoghar

The current US Ambassador to Bangladesh, His Excellency Dan W. Mozena visited Moanoghar on last 2 April 2012. He was accompanied by his wife Ms. Grace Mozena and a team that included Chief of Mission of USAID in Bangladesh.

He was received by a group of children in presence of Rotarian Ahmed Farooque. General Secretary of Wildlife and Nature Conservation Society Bangladesh (WNCSB) and Ms. Nirupa Dewan, Vice President of Moanoghar Executive Committee. He visited the project site of Moanoghar Ecopreservation Project, funded by US Cultural Centre. He, along with the other members of delegation planted trees while visiting the project site.

Later he visited the Moanoghar campus and attended a cultural function of the children.

Results of SSC Examinations and Launching of Moanoghar Higher Education Loan Programme (HELP)

The year's SSC result was published on 7 May. A total number of 144 students from Moanoghar Residential High School (MRHS) appeared at the last SSC Examinations; 109 regular students and the remaining 35 students are irregular i.e. who failed in last year's examination and took part again this year.

In total 102 students pass which amounts to a rate of 71.52%. The rate is within the average of Chittagong Education Board under which Moanoghar School falls.

Related to the above information, Moanoghar has re-launched the **Higher Education Loan Programme (HELP)** from this year. As part of this new initiative, students after SSC are provided education loan for further studies at tertiary level, which they will refund once they enter into employment after completion of studies.

As of now, only students from Moanoghar are supported from the programme. However, non-Moanoghar students belonging to the ethnic minority communities of CHT will also be gradually included depending on the availability of funds. The programme is currently funded by contributions from the former students of Moanoghar who completed their studies with similar support from Moanoghar. At present 22 students are supported under HELP.

A Team from France Visit Moanoghar

A team from the French association 'Les Amis des Jummas' visited Moanoghar in late March'12. The team comprised of Robert Clochon, Vice President of the association and his wife Dominique Clochon who volunteers with the organization.

Currently, the association sponsors some 20 children of Moanoghar. They spent a day at Moanoghar and met with the sponsored children. Moanoghar authority made a presentation to them of the overall activities and pointed out areas where their further support would be beneficial.

Publication of Video Film by "Chadigang Shilpigoshti" held

The inauguration program of the publication of a video film (Chakma drama) was held on 16 May at Moanoghar Conference Hall. Mr. Jhimit Jhimit Chakma, the Head Teacher of Moanoghar Residential High School was present as the Chief Guest. Advocate Chanchu Chakma, former Executive Director (and currently Adviser) and Mrs. Goirika Chakma, Senior Assistant Teacher were present as special guest. Supan Chakma, a Moanoghar student who is now studying in Rajshahi University of Engineering and Technology Electrical in Engineering presided over the function. The Chadigang Shilpigosti is a cultural association of the current and former students of Moanoghar. The video film was projected following the ceremony.
