Moanoghar Residential School Academic Planning for 2019

The academic planning of the Moanoghar Residential School for the upcoming academic year 2019 was approved in August 2018. The meeting was facilitated by Kirti Nishan Chakma, General Secretary of Moanoghar Executive Committee and jointly led by Ven. Shradhdhankar Mahathero and Mr. Jhimit Jhimit Chakma, respectively, President and Principal of Moanoghar Residential School.

The planning will be finalized through a series of participatory exercises involving the teachers, school managing committee, parents and guardians, along with the Moanoghar management. The overarching objective is **to improve the quality of academic standard in Moanoghar Residential School**, although the recent track records in the national competitive examinations of its students make among the best performing schools in the Rangamati district, indeed across the CHT region.

As part of the measures that have been, so far, taken, 5 (five) specific Task Groups have been set up, each with clear terms and goals. The task groups are: (1) Academic Improvement; (2) Resource Mobilization and Management; (3) Extra-curricular activities; (4) Administration and coordination (5) Communication and public relations. Each task group will work with specific terms of reference under the guidance of a Senior Management Team ensuring the overall coordination and administrative support.

The school will also start operating on morning shift from January 2019 which will allow extra-curricular activities to the students in the afternoon. Further, from the 2nd quarter of 2019, the school will arrange special coaching for the weak students and as well as separate coaching for those in class 5 (PSC), class 8 (JSC) and SSC candidates.
