Moanoghar Mobile Health Clinic Inaugurated

Moanoghar Mobile Health Clinic was inaugurated on 28 October 2009 at Moanoghar Conference Hall. It was inaugurated by the Rangamati District Civil Surgeon Dr. Md. Abdullah and he also attended the ceremony as Chief Guest with the Deputy Civil Surgeon Dr. Uday Shankar Dewan as Special Guest. Dr. Md. Abdullah thanked the Moanoghar Authority for their noble initiative. He hoped that the poor community will be benefited with this humanitarian endeavor. He ensured all his assistance for smoothly running the program. He requested Moanoghar Authority to contact with him without any hesitation for any help. Reputed journalist Mr. Hari Kishore Chakma, Moanoghar Residential School's Head Teacher Mr. Khokan Bikash Barua were present in the function which was presided over by Ven. Shraddha Lankar Mahathero, the vice-president of Moanoghar Executive Committee.

A medical team consists of 1 medical officer (MBBS), 1 medical assistant and 4 volunteers of Moanoghar Mini Hospital will provide treatment and medicine free of cost to the poor and needy community people. Preliminarily these services will be available in four sub-centers at Sapchari, Vedvedi, Rangapani and Kheppopara located at the vicinity of Rangamati municipality.

Annual Examination and Final Examination of Class V Held

Annual Examination of Moanoghar Residential School was held from 14 November to 2 December 2009. The results will be published in January 2010 (they have already published by the time of drafting this news bulletin).

The results were very good, particularly in comparison to the previous years.

In December, the Final (samapani) examination of class V students under the Education Board was also held. 86% of the students passed in the examination, with 10 students who obtained Grade A.

NCTF Rangamati District Committee Formed on December

11 member National Children Task Force (NCTF) Rangamati District Committee was formed on 20 December 2009. This is an initiative of Save the Children (Australia) in Bangladesh to promote the rights of the children.

Pali Examinations Held at Moanoghar Pali College

The final examinations in 3 different levels under the Bangladesh Pali and Sanskrit Education Board were held at Moanoghar Pali College from 22-24 December 2009. The levels of Examinations were respectively – the **Adya**, the **Madhya** and the **Upadhi**. This year, a total of 93 students sat at the **Pali Examinations**, among them 53 were of the **Adya**, 22 were of the **Madhya** and the rest 23 were of the **Upadhi** examinees.

The results of examinations are expected to be published in the 1st quarter of 2010.
