Moanoghar Technical School Launched

The Moanoghar Technical School was re-launched with courses on new vocational trades in February. It was inaugurated by the Vice President of Moanoghar Executive Committee Ven. Shraddhalanker Mahathero.

Three new courses are included in curriculum; Mobile Phone repairing, Basic Electronics and Home Electric repairing and maintenance. These are besides the courses on Carpentry, Weaving and Sewing.

Mr. Basana Bikash Chakma has been appointed as Director of the school. 60 students have enrolled in the school in various courses.

The Rashed Chowdhury, Saif and Bilquis Trust Merit Scholarships Launched

"The Rashed Choudhury Saif and Bilquis Trust Merit Scholarship" Award Giving Ceremony was held on 5 March at Moanoghar. A prominent industrialist and philanthropist, Mr. Rashed Choudhury declared the Scholarship during his visit at Moanoghar on 26 February. The Award will be limited in class seven, eight, nine and ten. The students, who stand 1st in class VII, VIII, IX and X will receive respectively 5,000 taka, 6,000 taka, 7,000 taka and 8,000 taka a year.

Rinika Chakma (VII), Sukel Chakma (VIII), Runi Chakma (IX) and Anupam Chakma (X) received the scholarship. They received the awards from Philips Crabtree an honorary part time teacher at Moanoghar Residential School who also taught Mr. Rashed Chowdhury in school.

• Foundation Course and Coaching in Moanoghar Residential School Initiated

Foundation Course for the students of Moanoghar Residential School was initiated from February 2011. The basic objective of the Foundation Course and special coaching is to improve the capacity of students in Science, English and Mathematics. Moanoghar School teachers and Moanoghar staffs take the classes after the school hours. Students are grouped in batches of 30-35 according to class.
