SSC results of Moanoghar School Published

The results of Secondary School Certificates (SSC) were published in May 2011. In total 138 students took part from Moanoghar in the exams. Among them 107 students passed which amounts to a pass rate of 79%, higher than the national average and also, for Moanoghar School, from the previous years. 1 student obtained A+ with 11 A and a further 20 received A-.

Moanoghar receives support from Rangamati Hill District Council

Moanoghar received a grant from the Rangamati Hill District Council (RHDC) to start a 1 year pilot vocational training programme. The grant was part of UNDP/CHTDF's institutional support to RHDC from its Economic Development Cluster.

An MoU has already been signed in this regard between Moanoghar and Rangamati Hill District Council. Chanchu Chakma, Executive Director of Moanoghar and Mr. Md. Irfan Sharif, Chief Executive Officer of RHDC signed the MoU on behalf of their respective organizations.

The trainings will start from July and in total courses on the following trades will be offered; (1) Automobile & driving, (2) Mobile phone repairing, and (3) Tailoring & dress making. A total 40 trainees will be offered training for the 3 courses and the RHDC will select the trainees and they all be provided the residential facilities and the training by Moanoghar. The courses are for 3 months each and started on a pilot basis.

Moanoghar launches Indigenous Mother Tongue Learning Programme

Moanoghar Residential School launched an initiative to teach the children their mother tongues. For a start, three indigenous languages – Chakma, Marma and Tripura – will be taught in the school. The programme will gradually include languages of other indigenous minority groups.
