Meeting with the parents and guardians

Annual Examination Result of Moanoghar Residential School

Annual examination results of Moanoghar Residential School were published on 28 December 2010. The results show steady progress from the previous year with pass rate over 92%. This puts Moanoghar school among the first few best performing schools in Rangamati.

In total 121 students from Moanoghar appeared in the government's Junior School Certificate (JSC) examination in class VIII. This is a recent initiative of the government from 2010 to hold central examinations at class VIII through the education boards. Moanoghar School achieved 90% pass rate.

Moanoghar School students also took part in the government's 'Samapani' examination of Class V. In total 78 students took part; 37 boys and 32 girls, out of which 70 students passed.

By the time of drafting this News Bulletin, Moanoghar students are appearing in SSC examination. The detailed information will be provided in the next issue.

Guardians Meeting Held: 19 December 2010:

A parents-guardian meeting of Moanoghar students was held on 19 December 2010. Ven. Shraddha Lanker Mahathero, Vice President of Moanoghar Executive Committee presided over the meeting.

Around four hundred guardians attended the meeting. The parents/guardians were informed of the plans and activities of next year and as well the achievements, gaps and financial situation of the past year.

Buddhadatta Bhikkhu, Joint Secretary Mr. Sonadhan Chakma and the Director of Moanoghar Adv. Chanchu Chakma spoke in the meeting. Some guardian representatives also spoke in the meeting.

3 Year Plan of Moanoghar formulated

With the objective of continued improvement of its organizational practices, sustainability and well-being of the children, Moanoghar has recently developed a 3 year plan which will be implemented over the period 2011-2013.

The Plan was developed with the help of Tony Hopkins, a former volunteer from VSO.
