Moanoghar Students Participate and Win in the Bangladesh National Level Sports Tournament

The final tournament of national level sports competition for the high school level students was held on 3rd February 2014 at the divisional Borishal stadium ground. The honorable minister of education Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid was present as chief guest. participants in tournament were selected through a nation-wide selection process.

Three students of Moanoghar were qualified for the national game. Pranay Chakma (Class X) won two gold medals for Shortput and Discus and Rebata Chakma (Class IX) won silver in discus.

At Chittagong regional tournament, Neeti Chakma (Class X) won the first prize in discus.

Annual Sports Day and Education Tour of Moanoghar School Held

The annual sports day of Moanoghar Residential School was held on last 11th February 2014 at Moanoghar play ground. All children in the school participated in the various events with much enthusiasm which included specific events both for the boys and the girls. These were organized around age group and class.

The day was inaugurated by Jhimit Jhimit Chakma, Head Teacher of Moanoghar School in presence of members from the neighbouring communities and Moanoghar authority.

The prize giving ceremony will be separately held in April 2014.

On a separate but related event, the students of class 10 of Moanoghar School went on an annual educational excursion tour on last 9 - 12 March'14. They went to Srimangal and Moulvibazar, Sylhet. The students visited the tea garden areas and the various nearby places. They also interacted there with various indigenous ethnic communities of the Garo, Manipuri and Khasi peoples and visited the Kamalganja Manipuri Literary Academy. The Academy authority held a special presentation for the students on their activities and about the life of the various indigenous communities in the vicinity.

They also interacted with the tea garden communities.

Runi Chakma and Shovarani Chakma A Promise for Future CHT and Bangladesh

Runi Chakma and Shovarani Chakma, both currently are studying in HSC in University Women's Federation College in Dhaka. Runi studies in Commerce section while Shovarani opted for Science.

Their story is identical to the hundreds of children who are currently sheltered in Maonoghar. One may even raise this number if one were to take into account former children who have left Moanoghar after completion of studies.

Runi took admission in 2004 and Shovarani in 2006, in class II and IV. Runi's father is a fringe farmer/day labour from Langadu upazila and Shovarani's parents are jum cultivator from Rangamati upazila. Both excelled in their studies and in SSC examinations obtained GPA score of 5.

After SSC Rotary Club of Dhaka, Kawran Bazar offered them full tuition to study in Dhaka, with further complementary support by the Moanogharians, the alumnae association of the former students.

Runi aspires to pursue business studies after HSC and Shovarani's aim is to become a medical doctor.

Moanoghar Students Grab all Three Prizes
