#### Results of SSC 2014 of Moanoghar Residential School

The results of the SSC examination 2014 of all education boards had been out on last 17 May 2014. This year a total of 149 students – regular (114) and irregular (35) - from Moanoghar Residential School (MRS) appeared in the SSC examination. Of them were 83 boys and 66 girls. Out of the total number of students, 113 students passed, accounting for 75.84% pass rate of the total number, which was slightly better than last year (73.13%). The details of the year-wise results is given below;

This year, out of the total students, 14 and 19 students respectively obtained 'A' and 'A-', but none could get GPA-5 (A+). Across the groups, the students of Business Studies did better (84.62%) than the other groups: Science and Humanities. The subjects that students find most difficult also remain the same; Math, English and Physics. A vast majority of the students who failed in the examinations are because of (one of) these 3 subjects.

# Denis Wright Memorials Scholarships 2014 Awarded

The Denis Wright Scholarships were awarded on 8 April 2014 through a small ceremony at Moanoghar central dining hall. The following three girl students received the award this year;

Eli Chakma comes from Khagrachari district. When she was 2 years old, her father died. Her mother is a housewife and ekes out a living by toiling on a small plot of land she inherited from her father.

Eli would like to be a teacher in future.
